

EDUCATION GRANT APPLICATION

The education grant fund is meant to help guild members develop advanced skills in quilting that they can bring back to the guild. Examples might be appraising quilts, judging quilts or working with the "Boxes Under the Bed" documentation project. These grants are separate from the scholarship fund that gives money to college students, who generally are not guild members.

The education fund will be handled by applications to the Education Grant Committee. The committee consists of three guild members appointed by the president. The guild members chosen can receive up to a \$1,000.00 grant. A maximum of \$2,000.00 will be given away in any one year. Finalists will be recommended to the guild board at the November board meeting. The guild board has the final decision on the recipient(s) of the grant(s). The recipient(s) will be awarded their grant(s) at the December general guild meeting.

Once a grant is awarded, a contract with the guild will be signed clarifying what will be done with the grant. Upon completion of the project, a grant recipient will be required to share the knowledge gained with the guild. This may be done through mini demonstrations, slide presentations, workshops or other way described by the recipient in this application that do not compromise copyright.

To apply for an educational grant you must complete the application attached and be a current guild member. Finalists will be interviewed by the presidents appointed committee. The application must be received by the president no later than October 15.
