

## Materials

1 x Phased Circle Pattern (Printed version available in class for purchase - \$12)

One (1) yard White Solid fabric

Blue Block:

One (1) yard Blue Solid<sup>1</sup>

Four (4) Fat Eighths (9in x 21in) Blue Low Volume fabrics

One (1) Fat Eighths Blue print<sup>2</sup>

Pink Block:

One (1) yard Pink Solid<sup>1</sup>

Four (4) Fat Eighths (9in x 21in) Low Volume fabrics (Pink or Grey)

One (1) Fat Eighths Pink print<sup>2</sup>

Green Block:

One (1) yard Green Solid<sup>1</sup>

Four (4) Fat Eighths (9in x 21in) Green Low Volume fabrics

One (1) Fat Eighths Green print<sup>2</sup>

Mustard/Yellow Block:

One (1) yard Mustard/ Yellow Solid<sup>1</sup>

Four (4) Fat Eighths (9in x 21in) Mustard/ Yellow Low Volume fabrics

One (1) Fat Eighths Mustard/ Yellow print<sup>2</sup>

Orange Block:

One (1) yard Orange Solid<sup>1</sup>

Four (4) Fat Eighths (9in x 21in) Orange Low Volume fabrics

One (1) Fat Eighths Orange print<sup>2</sup>

Teal Block:

One (1) yard teal Solid<sup>1</sup>

Four (4) Fat Eighths (9in x 21in) teal Low Volume fabrics

One (1) Fat Eighths teal print<sup>2</sup>

In addition to the standard sewing equipment (including sewing machine rotary cutter, cutting mat, pins, quilting ruler) you will need:

- 3 3/4 and 4 1/2 in radius for drunkard's path templates or an Olfa Circular Rotary cutter or freezer paper and a compass.
- 10 sized Needle<sup>3</sup>
- Six (6) 80wt applique thread (will vary based on block color)<sup>4</sup>

### Notes on Materials:

<sup>1</sup>The solids should be saturated and complement the prints selected for each block.

<sup>2</sup> Each of the prints should read as a solid. Take a step back and it should look mostly like the main color

<sup>3</sup> 10 Size Needle is the recommended needle size, but you can use other embroidery/sewing needles you have on hand.

<sup>4</sup>Thread should match the low volumes prints in each block
