This dynamic quilt can be made using purchased yardage, pre-cuts or scraps! Supplies listed are for a 12-block quilt. You are welcome to make yours larger or smaller.

You'll Need:

1. Your machine in good working order, with a new needle. Remember your power cord, foot pedal and user's manual.
2. Rotary cutting mat and ruler
3. Small, square ruler (I use 9 ½" Omnigridd)
4. Basic sewing supplies (scissors, pins, neutral thread, seam ripper, etc.).
5. 18" square of fleece, batting or muslin to lay out your pieces
6. "What's my Angle" tool and template. If you can't find it, Linda will have some in class for purchase at \$10.
7. Scotch tape



Yardage: (5 colors and a background):

Color #1: 1 ¼ yards (this is the focal color for each block)

Cut (3) 8 ½" strips, then cut each strip into (16) 2 ½" x 8 ½" rectangles

Cut (3) 4 ½" strips, then cut each strip into (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

Colors #2 and #3: ½ yard of each

Cut (6) 2 ½" strips of each color, then cut each strip into (16) 2 ½" squares

Colors #4 and #5: ¼ yard of each

Cut (3) 2 ½" strips of each color, then cut each strip into (16) 2 ½" squares

Background: 3 ½ yards

Cut (6) 4 ½" strips, then cut each strip into (8) 4 ½" squares

Cut (6) 2 ½" strips, then cut each strip into (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles

Cut (15) 2 ½" strips, then cut each strip into (16) 2 ½" squares

Borders:

Border #1: (background) (2) 2 ½" x 52 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips

Border #2: (checkerboard) randomly pieced checkerboard using (140) 2 ½" squares

Border #3: (background) (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" x 76 ½" strips.
